SITE USE AND FUNCTIONALITY

General Education Classrooms

Buildings A & B: These classroom buildings are newly constructed and highly collaborative. A central collaboration area is built into each building and designed in such a way that it can convert to a classroom if enrollment requires.

Classrooms have built-in casework at the sink area and mobile shelving. Walls have large areas of writable surface with tackable areas above. Furniture is highly flexible; student desks have wheels and a writable surface.

A large retractable wall joins the classrooms to the collaboration area.

Presentation technology includes a ceiling-mount projector and pull-down screen.

Building C: Classrooms are organized to surround a central pull-out space. Classrooms have a teaching wall and perimeter casework. Students have individual desks and detached chairs. Technology includes a ceiling-mount projector with pull-down screen as well as a mobile LCD monitor.



The center of the pod is used for pull-out services and storage.

Building E: Classrooms align along a doubleloaded corridor. Classrooms have a teaching wall with built-in casework and a sink. Cubbies for student belongings align an interior wall within the classroom. Backpack hooks are also mounted along the interior hallway. Students have individual desks and detached chairs. Technology includes a ceiling-mount projector with pull-down screen as well as a mobile LCD monitor.

Special Education Classrooms

The site's Mild/Moderate Special Education programs are held in typical classrooms, grouped with the classes of same-age peers.

Student Services / Counseling

A future phase of construction will rebuild these spaces.

Staff and Administrative Spaces

The Administration and front office are currently housed in temporary spaces near the new dropoff and staff parking lot and will be rebuilt new in a future phase of construction.

Kitchen / Cafeteria / Food Service

The kitchen is located within the Multi-Purpose Room. Hot and cold food carts are set up near the kitchen for the student serving line.

Students dine at outdoor tables underneath temporary shade structures. A lunch shelter will be added soon.

Student Assembly

The MPR has in-wall tables and two (2) retractable basketball hoops and backstops. The space has a ceiling-mount projector and wall-mounted speakers.

This site does not have a permanent stage. A temporary stage is stored in a room of the MPR building.

Library

A temporary Library is set up in the collaboration space of the new Building B. A reading room also occupies one of the portable buildings near Administration. A new Library is planned for a future phase of construction.

Outdoor Play Equipment / Playfields / Hardcourts

Hardcourts, play equipment, and playfields have all been recently installed.

Specialized Elective Spaces

The Science / Exploration Lab is located in Building E. The room has a teaching wall, perimeter casework, and a kitchenette with oven, stove, microwave, refrigerator, and a dishwasher. Furniture within this room is comprised of science-grade tables and stools. A center-mount projector and drop-down screen are present, as is a mobile LCD monitor.

The site does not currently have a Music room.

Restrooms

Modernization is desired for the restrooms. Not all TK/Kindergarten classrooms have attached restrooms.

Site / Parking / Drop-Off

The site has a new drop-off lane and staff parking along Sandalwood Drive. The campus also utilizes the original drop-off lane along Highland Oaks Drive.

Technology

Classroom technology has been upgraded with a mobile LCD monitor.
