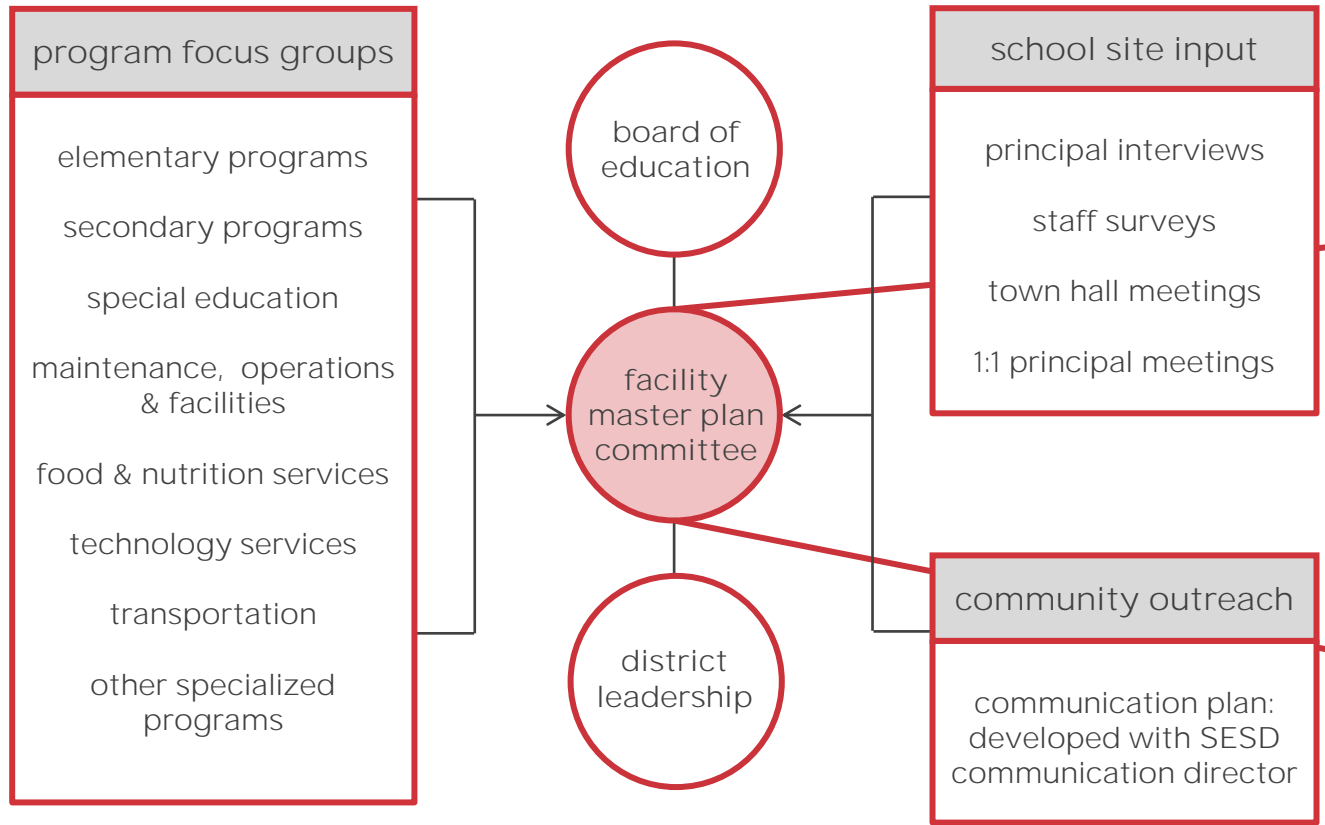
- FMP is first step in facilities improvement process
