### Priority Alignment

Across all school sites, the priorities most commonly align to these scope categories:

- Site-Wide Modernization & Deferred Maintenance
- Building Systems: Restrooms & Power Access
- Flexible Furniture

The prioritization of Modernization & Deferred Maintenance specifically reflects a prioritization of improved HVAC systems and ventilation. This could be in response to the state of the COVID-19 pandemic at the time the survey was taken.

The prioritization of Building Systems: Restrooms & Power Access specifically reflects a prioritization of new or modernized student and staff restrooms.

### District-Wide: Scopes of Work

Each FMPC member was provided four (4) stars to use to indicate their priorities for the scope of work categories. They were allowed to group stars together to place more than one star in a single category, or split them up into multiple categories. The three (3) scopes that received the most stars are:

14. Outdoor Learning Environments and Quads
2. Classrooms: Modernize & Reconfigure
1. Site-Wide: Deferred Maintenance

Coincidentally, this aligns with the greatest overlap in priorities from each school site (the chart on the left).

### Site-By-Site Voting

While FMPC members voted for the scope-of-work categories by school site, they were able to spend their limited number of dots however they liked. They could use all dots on a single school or scope category or spread them out. This resulted in each site receiving different sums of votes. Total votes by site are as follows:

Bishop Elementary School	<b>15</b> (4%)
Cherry Chase Elementary School	<b>41</b> (11%)
Cumberland Elementary School	<b>41</b> (11%)
Fairwood Explorer Elementary School	<b>37</b> (10%)
Lakewood Tech EQ Elementary School	<b>32</b> (9%)
San Miguel / Juntos Elementary School	<b>34</b> (9%)
Vargas Elementary School	<b>48</b> (13%)
Columbia Middle School	<b>32</b> (9%)
Sunnyvale Middle School	<b>83</b> (23%)
